

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Guidelines

1. Minimum Required PPE (DIY / Consumer Use)

- P2 or N95 dust mask (mandatory during fibre application and sanding).
- Safety glasses (AS/NZS 1337.1 compliant recommended).
- Nitrile or chemical-resistant gloves when handling adhesive.
- Work in a well-ventilated area at all times.

2. Recommended PPE (Professional / Workshop Use)

- Half-face respirator with P2 particulate filters for high-volume or enclosed applications.
- Disposable coveralls or long-sleeve protective clothing.
- Hearing protection when using powered sanding or air systems.
- Apron when working with tinted adhesive or pigments.

3. Warehouse Handling Requirements (Internal Use)

- P2 respirator when transferring or decanting bulk fibres.
- Nitrile gloves and safety glasses when handling adhesive.
- Store fibres and adhesives in sealed containers away from moisture.
- Maintain adequate ventilation in storage and packing areas.

4. Safety Warnings

- Do not inhale airborne fibres.
- Avoid prolonged skin contact with adhesive.
- Keep out of reach of children.
- Do not eat, drink or smoke during application.
- Wash hands thoroughly after use.
